We offer businesses free, on-site reviews to identify opportunities for improving resource efficiency, along with ongoing practical help with implementation, tailored information services, and a range of training and networking events.

We also help businesses to use the ENWORKS Online Resource Efficiency Toolkit. This bespoke software allows them to prioritise and manage their improvement actions and to report on the resulting cost and resource savings in real time.

Our focus is firmly on improving resource efficiency – making more with less – but we also address pertinent issues such as: corporate responsibility, environmental risk management, legal compliance, climate change adaptation, greening supply chains and sustainable procurement.

It's not rocket science

A survey commissioned by the NWDA in 2009 revealed that, without support, just 20% of North West businesses said they hoped to improve their resource efficiency in the following 12 months. Most were only looking at low impact initiatives and it is unlikely that all of those were implemented.

Left alone, most local businesses will fail to take effective action, even if they know they should. Simple, low-cost efficiency improvements can make a major difference to future prosperity at a local level and help to meet national and international climate change obligations.

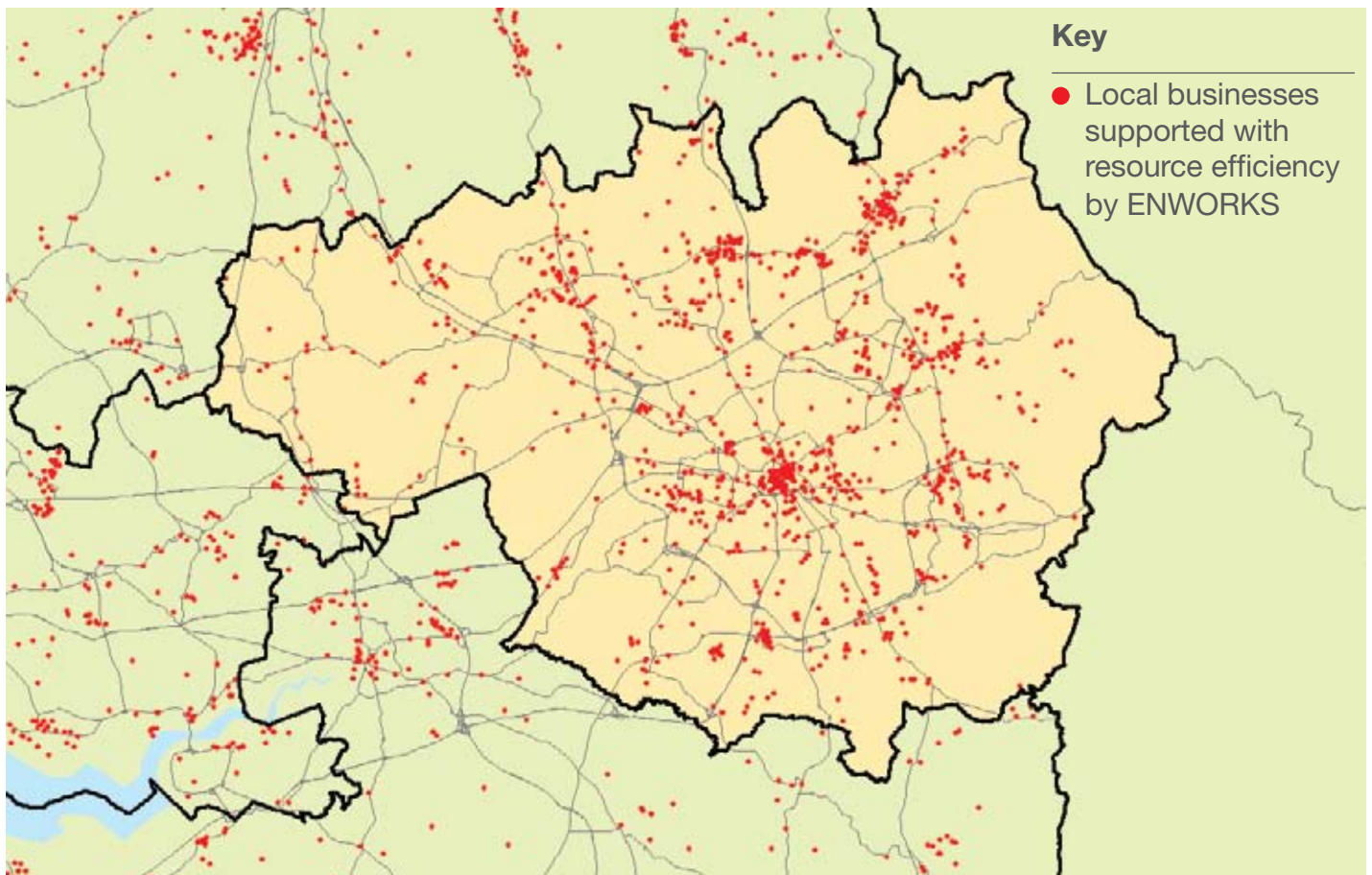
Since 2001, £19.5 million has been invested in Greater Manchester businesses through the ENWORKS partnership, primarily by the NWDA and ERDF.

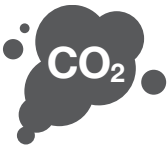

Business cost savings per year

- We help local businesses to boost their bottom line.
- We’ve achieved £11.3 million of annual cost savings (including 56% at zero capital cost) and we have another £37.5 million in the pipeline.
- From these achieved annual savings we’ve already accrued £41.5 million of cumulative cost savings to date in Greater Manchester businesses.

193,700 tonnes



CO₂e savings per year

- We’re specialists at helping businesses to reduce their carbon footprints.
- We’ve achieved 44,600 tonnes of annual savings in Greater Manchester businesses and we have another 149,100 tonnes in the pipeline.
- From these we’ve already accrued 172,100 tonnes of cumulative savings to date, which is equivalent to the amount you would emit by driving a Hummer from Manchester to the moon, 1,300 times.

2.2 million m³



Water savings per year

- We help businesses to protect precious natural resources by reducing water consumption in products, processes and facilities.
- We’ve achieved 737,300 m³ of annual savings in Greater Manchester businesses and we have another 1.4 million m³ in the pipeline.
- From these we’ve already accrued 2 million m³ of cumulative savings to date, which is equivalent to filling over 830 Olympic swimming pools.

Material savings per year

- We take a fresh look at how materials are procured and used, to help businesses to make more with less.
- We’ve achieved 2.2 million tonnes of annual savings in Greater Manchester and we have another 22,200 tonnes in the pipeline.
- From these we’ve already accrued 17.1 million tonnes of cumulative savings to date; enough to build more than 6,600 Blackpool Towers.

Waste diverted from landfill per year

- We help businesses to increase their re-use, recycling and recovery rates, by treating residual waste as a fresh resource or income stream.
- We’ve achieved 26,200 tonnes of annual savings in Greater Manchester businesses and we have another 131,700 tonnes in the pipeline.
- From these we’ve already accrued 73,600 tonnes of cumulative savings to date; the weight of about 10,500 African elephant bulls.

Case Studies

The Lowry Hotel

Total cost savings: £133,100 pa

The five-star Lowry Hotel in Salford has been working closely with a local ENWORKS adviser from Groundwork MSSTT to improve its environmental performance. A range of opportunities are being implemented to improve resource efficiency and reduce operational costs.

These have included replacing old light bulbs with new, more energy efficient LED bulbs, implementing a computer switch-off policy outside of working hours, and fitting thermostatic controls to radiators to lower ambient temperatures by 1°C. As a result, the hotel is making annual savings of £25,100 in electricity costs and £29,100 in heating bills.

Groundwork is supporting managers with ongoing work to fit water aerators to taps and install

low-flow shower heads to reduce water consumption, and to implement recycling initiatives to divert waste from landfill.

These initiatives could reduce water bills by £19,500 a year and save £23,300 on annual waste charges. An ongoing lighting maintenance programme could save a further £36,100 each year.

The Lowry Hotel is already making annual savings of £54,200 a year on its electricity and heating bills and there is scope for it to save a further £78,900 a year in energy, water and waste bills.

The identified and achieved savings come with annual CO₂e savings of over 400 tonnes and water savings of over 9,700 m³ a year.

INX International UK Ltd

Total cost savings: £53,000 pa

Rochdale-based INX International UK manufactures inks for printing on drinking cans. The business has been supported by a local ENWORKS adviser at Groundwork Oldham and Rochdale to significantly improve its resource efficiency.

Initiatives have included replacing two old compressors and fitting new timer controls and variable speed drive technology to improve energy efficiency. On Groundwork's advice, a low-energy chilling system has also been installed using a loan obtained from the Carbon Trust. The equipment has a payback period of four years, after which annual savings of £39,600 will start to accrue, year-on-year.

A power factor correction unit, thermostatic sensors and roller-door sensor have also been fitted to reduce heat loss from the premises, saving £13,000 a year, and water in

the chiller units is now re-used on site to reduce the amount being drawn from the mains supply, saving another £170 a year in water rates.

Further opportunities have been identified to routinely collect and recycle ink buckets from customers after use and reduce the amount of packaging waste generated.

ENWORKS has already helped INX International to achieve annual savings of £52,700 and the bucket recycling initiative could save a further £300 a year in waste charges. The identified and achieved savings come with annual savings of 300 tonnes of CO₂e, 120 m³ of water, and one tonne of waste diverted from landfill each year.
